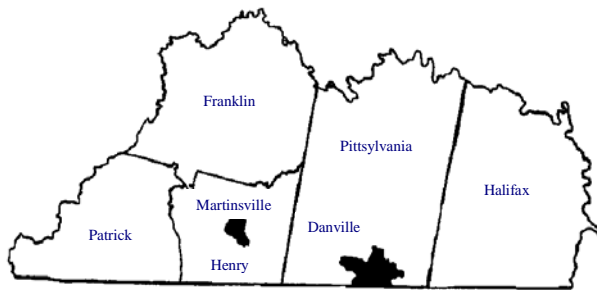


## Our Program...
