HISTORY AND DEVELOPMENT

Danville Community College is a 86-acre institution of higher education serving the City of Danville, Pittsylvania County and Halifax County. The main campus is located on South Main Street in Danville, Virginia, consisting of 11 College buildings.

Beginning as early as 1890, the campus of Danville Military Institute (1890 to 1939) housed prisoners of war during World War II(1944-1945), was home to the off-campus engineering division of Virginia Polytechnic Institute (named VPI Extension - Fall 1946 to 1950, Danville Branch of VPI - 1950 to 1965, and Danville Division of VPI - 1965 to 1968), and shared the campus with Danville Technical Institute (formerly Danville Textile School) from 1945 to 1966, until DTI merged with the Danville Division of VPI to form Danville Community College.

Danville Community College is governed by an advisory Board of nine members. The College is supervised by the Virginia Community College System (VCCS) and State Board for Community Colleges, and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, Georgia 30033-4097) to award associate degrees to those students successfully completing a curriculum.

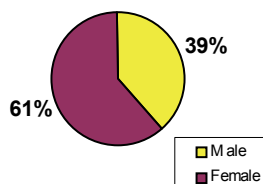
DID YOU KNOW...

- * DCC partners with area high schools for dual enrollment courses. College credits earned while in high school...for free! Local high schools participating include Chatham, Dan River, Galileo, Gretna, George Washington, Halifax County, and Tunstall.
- * Off-campus locations are: *Danville City:* RCATT, Camp Grove Center, GWHS, North Main Center, Seeland Crossing, and YMCA. *Halifax County:* Southern Virginia Higher Education Center, YMCA, and Moving Voices. *Pittsylvania County:* Cascade Center, Pittsylvania County Career and Technical Center, and The Riddle Center.
- * Approximately 726 students have been awarded over \$807,000 in financial aid as a result of the Tobacco Settlement dollars.
- * DCC students have full access to the campus Financial Aid office. Over 2000 students benefited from scholarships, grants and loans in 2005-06 totaling over 4.5 million dollars.
- * The Educational Foundation awarded over \$132,000 in scholarships during the 2006-07 academic year.
- * The Carrington Child Development Center offers on-campus childcare services.

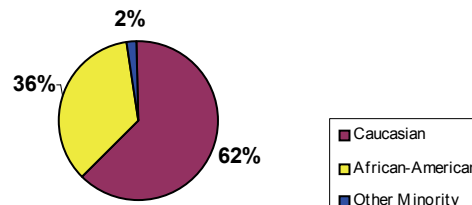

2007-2008**

The total financial aid for community college students increased \$3.49 million to \$21.8 million. This is a 19 percent increase over 2006-2007. A special financial aid fund for part-time students increased \$200,000 to \$11 million.
