***Instructions for using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool at www.fafsa.gov: To use the tool, go to www.fafsa.gov, log in to your FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. Follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2015 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA. It takes up to three weeks for IRS income information to be available for the IRS Data Retrieval Tool if you electronically filed an IRS tax return, or up to eleven weeks for paper IRS tax return filers.

If you are unable to provide tax transcripts, use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, or have filed amended taxes, contact the Financial Aid Office.
